Explorers Bible Study: Prophecy and the book of Revelation

This study seeks to bring together and open a broad spectrum of Scriptures dealing with prophecy, hopefully leading to a fuller understanding of their meaning and importance. The study begins with a look at Old Testament prophecies and their fulfillment in the life of the nation of Israel. Several lessons focus on the many prophecies concerning the coming Messiah and their fulfillment in Jesus Christ. The later portion of the study looks at prophecies that have yet to be fulfilled - those that many consider to be future or "end time."

Hebrews provides insight into the person, position, and power of Jesus Christ, and demonstrates their application in the life of the believer: our only confidence lies in Jesus Christ.
